

"Winter is the time for comfort, for good food and warmth, for the touch of a friendly hand and for a talk beside the fire: it is the time for home."

INDOOR:

Don't Breathe in Dirty Air: Remove the air supply grills and vacuum inside the ducts or hire a professional
Test every smoke detector and carbon monoxide detector. Don't forget to change the batteries
Dirty Filters Are Not Fun: Clean or change the furnace and humidifier filters. Do this once a month during the fall and winter. Help the units function more efficiently by doing this often
Avoiding Flooding: Clean your sump pump. Take care of this task before the rainy season begins so your sump pump is prepared for the wet weather. How: https://www.wikihow.com/Clean-out-a-Sump-Pit
Install Storm Windows & Store Screens
"The Fireside is Blazing Bright": Have fireplace/chimney cleaned and inspected
Check for moisture in the basement or crawl space
Clean Dryer Vent
Check Attic for signs of un-welcomed critters or moisture

Winterize your irrigation system. Hire a contractor. Do this before the first freeze.
Inspect the weather-stripping around all doors
Avoid Clogged Gutters: Clean them out before more rainfall and heavy snow pile with leaves underneath
Bring Hoses inside and shut off outdoor water valves
Protect Your Exterior From Salt & Ice: Seal the exterior concrete. Make sure you seal the concrete when it's dry outside.
Install a cover on your outdoor AC unit
Trim branches & trees away from the roof/house
Cut The Grass One Final Time Before The Snowfall
Bring in outdoor ponds/accessories
Empty out old pots and store in garage to avoid cracking from cold weather
